



## MPDS member Code of Conduct

Maintain all Safety Rules of MPDS and the operating range.

Retain a comprehensive understanding of the Current MPDS Rulebook.

Obey all instructions given by Range Officers.

Members may not misuse, abuse, or swear at any range official.

The safe handling of firearms and courtesy towards others is paramount. Members will always uphold and adhere to the four Rules of Gun Safety: All guns are always loaded. Never let the muzzle cover anything you are not willing to destroy. Keep your finger off the trigger until your sights are on the target. Be sure of your target and what is beyond it.

Each member is responsible for acquainting themselves with the location of all facility ranges and possible danger zones and will abide by any and all signs posted. Do not wander from established range/s without a RO.

MPDS management reserves the right to refuse/deny members and/or revoke memberships for misuse of facilities and/or violation of any MPDS rules of those rules of the hosting range. All direct violations of rules, in particular safety rules may result in full immediate revocation of membership.

Each range is to be used only for the purpose for which it is constructed, and all equipment must be approved prior to usage. All members shall treat the equipment and ranges with respect and report any and all equipment malfunctions and or maintenance needs to the Range Master.

All members must retain their own brass after each session. All trash to be placed in relevant bins. Attempt to leave the range in a better condition than you found it.

**NO ALCOHOL or CONTROLLED MATERIALS/SUBSTANCES allowed.**



No tracer or incendiary ammunition may be utilised unless by approval of the Range Master and/or Range Committee.

Violation of this Code of Conduct, Club rules & regulations, irresponsible behavior, or destruction of any MPDS property could result in disciplinary action and possible expulsion from MPDS and all involved clubs.
